<p>God's original plan was for Adam to populate and rule over the earth as a vicegerent on His behalf (Gen 1:28), but the plan was frustrated in its infancy when Adam fell shortly after creation before any people were born (Gen 3:1–7). God permitted Satan to tempt Adam soon after he was given authority to rule over the earth.</p>	<p>1441 BC Sinaitic Covenant between God and Moses to form a Theocratic Kingdom (possession of land)</p> <p>ANOINTING BY THE HOLY SPIRIT AND DECLARATION OF SONSHIP—appointment and empowerment of a human vicegerent on the earth (Matt 3:16–17) Jesus was anointed King by God (John 18:37), given authority over all of God's creation (Matt 11:27; 28:18; John 3:35; 13:3; 17:2), and promised a Kingdom (Luke 22:29), but never ruled on a throne in a kingdom (John 18:36) (similarly David was chosen and anointed king by God long before he acquired a throne and a kingdom)</p> <p>TEMPTATION—God permitted Satan to tempt Jesus right after he was given authority to rule the earth, but, unlike Adam, he successfully resisted temptation three times (Matt 4:1–11)</p>		<p>33 AD New Covenant with Jesus—the Covenant of the Kingdom</p>		<p>KINGDOM OF GOD—after successfully resisting temptation, Jesus begins forming the Kingdom of God on earth through persuasion (Matt 4:17), i.e., through preaching, teaching, healing, exorcisms, good works, and miracles (an attempt to restore human vicegerency on earth without force)</p> <p>PREACHING—Jesus told people he was the Anointed One—the Christ (Luke 4:16–21) and announced the nearness of the Kingdom of God (Matt 4:17; Mark 1:14–15)</p> <p>EXORCISM—demon possession was introduced after the fall and their removal shows the rule of man over the earth has been restored (Matt 12:28)</p> <p>HEALING—sickness was introduced after the fall and its removal shows the rule of man over the earth has been restored (Matt 9:35; Luke 9:1–6)</p> <p>POWER OVER NATURE—storms were introduced after the fall and their removal shows the rule of man over the earth has been restored (Matt 8:27)</p> <p>SHEPHERD IMAGERY—kings were called shepherds, as is the Messiah (Ezek 37:24), so shepherd imagery implies a human King (Matt 2:6; John 10:11–16)</p>		<p>Millennium</p> <p>Resurrection Body</p>
