



THE REIGN OF JESUS CHRIST

THE KING COMES AND OFFERS THE KINGDOM

1 An eternal Kingdom is prophesied in the OT (Dan 2:44, 7:14,18,27)

7 Jesus has all authority in heaven and on earth (Mt 11:27; 28:18; Jn 3:35; 13:3; 17:2)—over Satan, demons, men, nature, disease, Sabbath, sin, and death

2 Gabriel announces Jesus will be given David's throne and will rule forever (Lk 1:32-33)

3 Jesus is born King of the Jews (Mt 2:2)

4 Jesus is King of Israel (Lk 23:3; Jn 1:49)

8 God gave Jesus a Kingdom (Lk 22:29; Jn 18:36)

JEWISH AGE

9 God gave all judgment to Jesus (Jn 5:22, 27)

10 Jesus offers the Kingdom at His Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem (Mt 21:4-5; Mk 11:10; Lk 19:38-44; Jn 12:13-15)

THE REJECTED KING GOES INTO EXILE

(Parable of Ten Minas Lk 19:11-27)

13 Jesus is exalted and given the highest name in heaven and on earth (Phil 2:9-11)

All things are subordinated to Jesus (Eph 1:21-22, Heb 2:8b)

CHURCH AGE AND TRIBULATION

14 Apostles reoffer the Kingdom (Acts 3:19-21)

16 Jerusalem and Diaspora reject the Kingdom (Acts 4-28)

THE KING RETURNS TO RULE

MILLENNIAL KINGDOM

19 Jesus delivers the Kingdom to His Father and subordinates Himself to Him (1 Cor 15:24, 28)

18 Jesus reigns for 1000 years (Rev 20:4, 6)



17 Jesus sits on DAVID'S THRONE (Ps 110:2; Mt 19:28; 25:31-34, 40; Rev 3:21)

THE KING RULES FOREVER

ETERNAL KINGDOM

21 God creates a new heaven and earth (2 Pet 3:13). We will live in the New Jerusalem forever (Rev 21-22)

22 Jesus and God both rule in the Eternal Kingdom (Rev 22:1-5)

5 At his baptism Jesus is anointed King and given authority over all creation by God the Father (Mt 3:16)

JEWISH OPPOSITION AND VIOLENCE INCREASE

We do not yet see all things subordinated to Jesus (Heb 2:8c)

11 Gentiles give Jesus a crown of thorns (Jn 19:2, 5)

12 Jews reject the Kingdom and crucify the King (Lk 9:22; 17:25; Jn 19:15)

15 Apostles and early church leaders have delegated authority over Satan, demons, and disease (Acts 5:16; 8:6-7; 16:18; 19:11-12)

6 Jesus defeats Satan, retains His authority over all creation, and reclaims the scepter for man at His temptation (Mt 4:1-11; 28:18)

20 Present heavens and earth are destroyed (Ps 102:25-26; 2 Pet 3:10-12; Rev 21:1)

Jesus' rule on this earth ends but continues on the new earth
